

K1 CHARTERS TERMS & CONDITIONS + BOAT CONDUCT POLICY

1. Must Be a Certified Diver

All divers must hold a minimum of an Open Water Diver certification from a recognized agency. Proof of recent diving activity (within the past year) and experience in New England or similar cold-water conditions is required. Certification cards and logbooks will be verified prior to boarding,

2. Advanced Open Water

Participation in advanced charters is limited to divers with an Advanced Open Water certification, proven experience in similar environments, or those accompanied by a certified dive professional. Divers without appropriate credentials will be denied boarding and will not receive a refund.

3. Specialty Equipment Use

Use of specialty dive gear—such as drysuits, full-face masks, DPVs, rebreathers, doubles, or side-mount systems—requires proof of training or specialty certification. No exceptions. This is for your safety and the safety of others onboard.

4. Dive Charter Boat

K1 CHARTERS is a charter vessel operator. We do not provide dive instruction. If you require dive training or a guided dive experience, please contact our affiliated dive center, DiVE KS, located in Beverly, MA.

5. Rates & Charter Details

- Standard Charters: \$110 per diver
- Long-Range Charters: Pricing confirmed prior to booking
- Private Charters: Priced per hour, payable in full at time of booking
- Equipment Rentals: Not included. Contact DiVE KS in advance to reserve gear.

BOOKING, ARRIVAL & WEATHER

6. Arrival Policy

All guests must arrive 30 minutes prior to departure. The vessel will leave promptly at the scheduled time. Late arrivals will forfeit their spot without refund.

7. Weather, Marine Forecast & Motion Sickness

Marine forecasts may change unexpectedly. If you are prone to seasickness, please prepare in advance. Refunds will not be issued due to motion sickness. We reserve the right to cancel or reschedule charters due to weather, mechanical issues, or other circumstances. When possible, notice will be given the evening prior. Guests will be notified via call, text, or email and must confirm receipt. We are not responsible if you miss this notice. In rare cases, the captain may cancel at the dock. If a trip is canceled before departure, guests will have the opportunity to reschedule. No refunds for guest cancellations, no-shows, or late arrivals.

PASSES, TRANSFERS & REFUNDS

8. Season Pass Transfers

Season Passes are fully transferable under the following conditions:

- Replacement diver meets all certification/experience requirements
- All forms and waivers are completed in advance
- K1C is notified by email 48 hours prior to the charter

Abuse of this policy or failure to follow transfer steps may result in revocation of the pass without refund.

9. Respect & Safety Policy

Safety is our #1 priority. We treat all guests with courtesy and expect the same in return. We reserve the right to refuse or cancel bookings if another operation may be a better fit. Disrespectful behavior, unsafe diving, or refusal to follow safety instructions will result in denial of service and permanent blacklisting from future bookings.



10. No Refund Policy

All bookings, deposits, and season pass sales are final.

This includes cancellations due to illness, emergencies, or schedule changes. By booking, you agree to these terms in full.

GUEST RESPONSIBILITIES & CONDUCT

11. Guest Responsibilities

- All guests must complete a Liability Waiver and Medical Questionnaire.
- "Yes" responses on the medical form require physician clearance
- No alcohol or drugs permitted. Intoxicated guests will be denied boarding without refund.
- All participants must be comfortable swimming in open water. All guests must be
 physically capable of boarding the vessel and using the dive ladder unassisted. If you have
 mobility limitations or medical concerns that may impact your ability to dive safely, please
 contact us prior to booking.
- Full-face snorkel masks are not permitted.
- Photographs/videos may be taken. If you wish to opt out, notify us in writing prior to your trip.

12. Equipment & Liability Policy

- Tanks and Weights: Provided by DiVE KS and are their sole responsibility. K1C does not maintain, inspect, or supply these items.
- Concierge Gear Transport: If included with your package, K1C acts only as a transporter.
 We are not liable for the condition, performance, or suitability of any gear.
- To streamline operations and maximize deck space for the comfort and safety of all
 guests, we kindly ask divers to set up their gear upon arrival and boarding. We also
 request that divers bring a compact dive bag for essential items only. Large totes, roller
 bags, storage containers, and similar bulky items should be returned to your vehicle after
 setup. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.



13. Charter Calendar Access & Booking Policy

- The K1C Charter Calendar is released monthly. Season Pass holders receive exclusive early
 access based on the privileges outlined in their individual pass tier. During your designated
 pre-booking window, you'll have the opportunity to reserve charters in advance. Suggested
 dive sites will be provided as a reference, based on your certification level and diving
 experience. Specific site requests cannot be guaranteed.
- All charters require a minimum of 4 divers to operate.
- If a Season Pass holder pre-books a charter during their exclusive window but the minimum number of 4 divers is not met, the charter will not run as scheduled. In this case, we will:
- Notify you in advance.
- · Offer to reschedule your booking to another available charter date, or
- Allow you to transfer your booking credit to another eligible date within your pass period.
- Once the early access window closes, the calendar will open in phases to other Season Pass tiers, followed by the general public.

14. Minors Onboard

Divers under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a certified, participating parent or legal guardian. Unaccompanied minors are not permitted on board. Proof of age may be requested.

15. Gratuity Policy

Gratuities for the crew are not included in the charter pricing but are always appreciated for exceptional service. Tipping is at the discretion of the guest.

16. Trip Duration Disclaimer

Charter duration may vary depending on dive site, marine conditions, and group dynamics. Return times are approximate. Please plan your day accordingly, especially if coordinating post-charter activities.



17. Emergency Procedures & Evacuation

In the event of a medical emergency or vessel evacuation, all guests must comply with crew instructions immediately. Emergency decisions will be made by the captain and crew. No refunds or reschedules will be issued due to shortened trips caused by emergencies.

18. Lost or Forgotten Items

K1 CHARTERS is not responsible for lost, stolen, or forgotten personal belongings. Please double-check your gear and personal items before disembarking.

19. Parking & Dock Area Conduct

Guests are responsible for obeying all posted signs and regulations at the dock or marina. K1 CHARTERS is not liable for parking tickets, towing, or vehicle damage.

20. Surface Intervals & Decompression Safety

All divers are responsible for monitoring their own dive profiles, dive computers, and dive plans including surface intervals and no-decompression limits.

21. Health & Medical Disclosure

Failure to fully disclose any relevant medical conditions—either in the waiver or during pre-dive briefings—may result in denial of service without refund. Honest disclosure is critical to your safety and the safety of others.

22. Booking Confirmations

Bookings are not considered confirmed until payment has been received in full and a confirmation email has been issued. Availability is subject to change until this point.



Additional Notes for Divers

- Divers with fewer than 10 logged dives in New England or similar conditions must hire a certified guide at \$210.
